## DELF

### DELF Preparation workshop

The objective of this class is to equip students who are preparing for the DELF / DALF International Proficiency Exams, with the necessary tools to sit for the exams. During the class, the teacher will go through past year question, techniques for writing essays and for the oral part of the exam.

## DELF Examinations - Next Session November 2010

The DELF DALF diplomas are offered through regulated examinations that are held twice a year for the General Public and once a year for the specified Government schools. DELF & DALF are 6 independent Diplomas, delivered by French Ministry of Education, designed according to the CEFR (Common European Framework Reference) standard.

## Translation service

The Alliance Française is recognised by the Embassy of France as an official center for French translation. Certified documents translated by us bear the stamp of the Alliance Française de Kuala Lumpur. We translate from and to French for English and Bahasa Melayu to French. The time required to translate a document will depend on the volume and nature of the document. Simple translation requires at least 3 working days.

**Proficient user:** Good operational command of the language. Can understand a wide range of long and demanding texts and can recognize implicit meaning. Can express himself fluently in a well-structured way on his social, professional or academic life and on complex topics.
