The Competition

Green Affordable Residential Challenge – Urban Social Architecture 2010

The Idea

Year 4-5 advanced architecture students and students who study housing, building, planning or any other related disciplines and are presently enrolled fulltime in advance degree or advance diploma level courses (Part II LAM or equivalent) at Malaysian Tertiary Institutions may formulate and design affordable green housing with social infrastructure (e.g. encounter areas like playgrounds, sporting facilities etc.), flexible space (min. three bedrooms and two bathrooms), at an estimated cost of below RM100,000 per unit/ apartment, in a central urban area of high density medium rise (5-8 stories) and with consideration of the Malaysian Green Building Index (<http://www.greenbuildingindex.org/>).

Submission Format

1. On four A1 size papers or boards. On rear side: name, address, institution, and personal contact data as well as digital copy (softcopy) burned onto a DVD or CD in Jpeg format (unflattened).
2. Maximum of two students per Entry and Entry Form.
3. Submission with brief description of project on max. two A4 pages (max. 500 words) written in English including project name, concept, building size and type, occupancy, total project cost, list of energy efficiency measures and sustainable strategies.

Judging Criteria

- Concept (25%)
- Sustainability & Energy Efficiency of the House (30%)
- Practicality (25%)
- Aesthetics of Building Design (20%)

Training Support

- Green Building Public Lectures by Academics and Professionals in the Industry from France, Germany and Malaysia
(The free training and design input programs are tentatively scheduled for Sat, 17th July, Sat, 21st August, Sat, 25th September, 16th October at Universiti Malaya, 2-5pm, check homepages of AF, GI below for location, details and changes)
- The lectures will be held in Universiti Malaya and will be made available digitally (AF, GI, NST Webpages) for those students residing and studying outside of Kuala Lumpur and unable to attend the lectures in person.
- There will also be site visits and workshops to provide theoretical, technical and practical knowledge to all participants.

- Exhibition & Architecture Showcase of competition winning entries (in partnership with a local developer).
